The optic sulci (grooves) are the first parts of the eye to develop at the cranial pole of the embryo. Protrusion of the optic grooves coincides with embryonic folding, as the edges of the neural folds begin to come together. As they continue to grow outward from the primitive diencephalon, the optic grooves form the optic vesicles, which is continuous with the forebrain cavity.
